



Our strong military is in jeopardy....



Because after sequestration cuts kick in on March 1, 2013*:

- The Pentagon will face a \$52 billion shortfall and overall 800,000 Defense civilian workers will have to be furloughed.
- The Army will cut its base operations budget by 30% by decreasing recreational programs and utilities.
- The Air Force will undergo a hiring freeze, fire temporary employees, curtail flights "not directly related to readiness" including those at air shows and flyovers during special events, and possible 30-day unpaid leave for civilian employees.
- The Navy will suffer from a hiring freeze and a drastic reduction in travel, conferences and other non-essential spending.
- According to the Chairman of the Joint Chiefs of Staff Gen. Martin Dempsey, "The readiness of our Armed Forces is at a tipping point. Budget conditions unfolding right now are causing this readiness crisis."

Across-the-board cuts to domestic spending are NOT the answer!
